

Market Days 2009

Informational Sheet on Junior Exhibitor's Crafts

This year's event will be held the weekend of December 5th & 6th. The hours are 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. both days. *This is a two-day event to benefit the Tallahassee Museum of History and Natural Science; therefore exhibitors should plan to be present at their crafts table both Saturday and Sunday.*

All students through Grade 12 are eligible to participate.

Acceptable items include art, crafts and plants. No flea market items, baked goods, food items, or beverages are allowed to be sold in the Junior Exhibitor's tent.

All work entered must have been made by the exhibitor. If the Market Days committee feels that the items were not made by the exhibitor, the committee reserves the right to remove the items in question.

Booth set up is at 9:00 a.m. Saturday morning unless you want to sell to the early Bird Shoppers, in which case you will need to arrive at 7:00 a.m. to be ready by the 8:00 a.m. gate opening to these shoppers who have purchased a special ticket to get in early! A map will be sent to you that details where the tent will be located and the best access for parking and unloading.

Junior Exhibitors and their parents will not be able to shop during Early Bird hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, unless they have purchased Early Bird tickets.

This year, we are charging a flat \$15 per table exhibitor's fee instead of collecting 10% of your gross sales at the end of the show. This non-refundable fee will need to accompany your application; please make your check payable to the Tallahassee Museum. In addition, you will now be responsible for reporting and paying any sales tax that you may owe from your Market Days sales directly to the Department of Revenue.

You are accepted as a Junior Exhibitor unless we are overwhelmed by applications. In that case, the chairperson will call you. We may also call you if we have questions regarding the items you wish to exhibit. **Your booth number and other details (including your entrance pass) will be sent to you two weeks before Market Days 2009.** Meanwhile, get started on those wonderful crafts projects!! We'll see you at Market Days in December.
